5. COMMENTARY

At the end of yesterday, ES made its new high and closed at high range. This is bullish signal. But it lacked volume. Whether ES can breakout its major resistance level or not, depends on today's FOMC announcement and volume following through. Closing below 1384.50 level today will lead to tomorrow and Friday selling off for minor correction.



6. TODAY'S TRADING

Based on 60 mins chart, ES broke out 1384.50 level and closed above it. This morning we may see price continuing going up a little and then go sideways until FOMC announcement out at 14:15 pm est.

After announcement, price may whipsaw both sides. Nevertheless, major resistance level for ES is 1395 and support level is 1370.

Due to Fed Announcement, newbies should stay on sideline today.



Caution:

We are in election period. Many charting patterns and indicators suggest the market is on its top, but political considerations may limit any decline. Be cautious in the pre-election period. Normal trading methods may not work.
