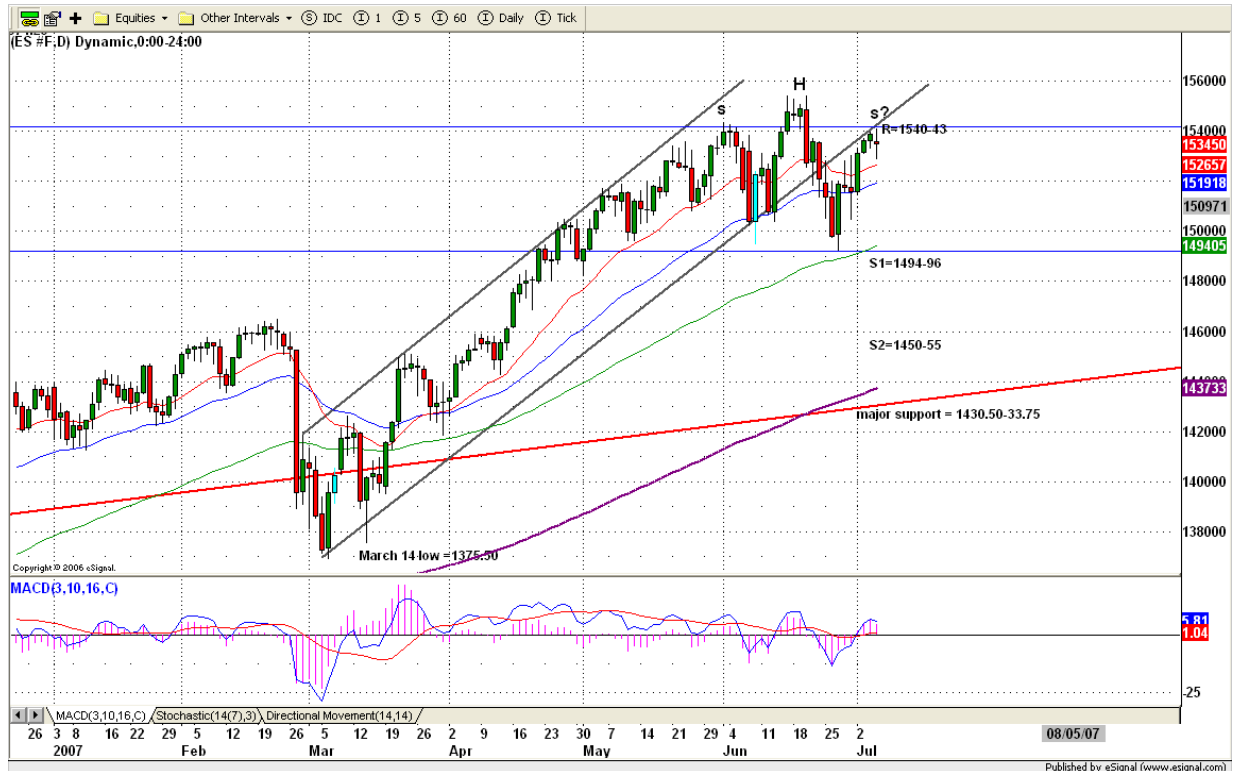

## 6. TRADING STRATEGY FOR July 6, 2007

Yesterday ES filled last Tuesday's gap at 1531. Later it managed to hold price above 1531 for closing. Today if job report is good, we may see ES go up to 1542-43 range to complete its bullish pattern. If report is not good, ES could dip fast down to 1521-19 range to search for support.

Today 1538 is key level. Above it, the market remains bullish. Watch for new highs made within first hour and scalp them on the short side..

**1540-43 (scalping) and 1546.75 (agg) and 1551.75-54.25(cons)**  
**Intraday swing position entry on long side:**  
**1525.25 (scalping) 1520.25 (agg) and 1515.50(cons)**

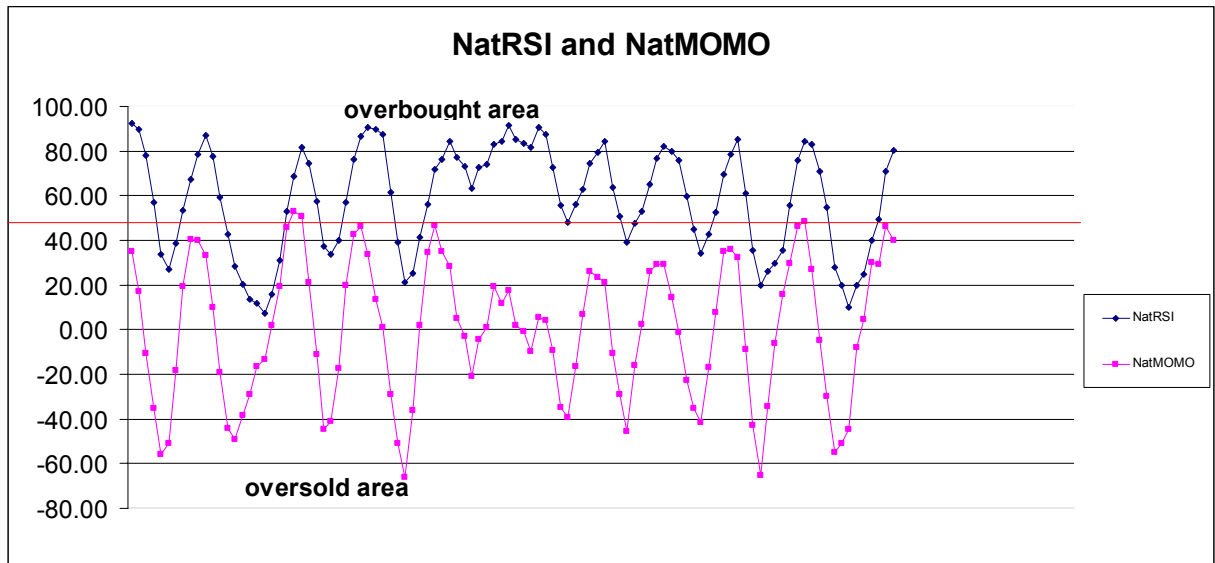
